RULES AND REGULATIONS

For quick service, look up numbers before calling. If no number is given, then call by name. Many numbers have been changed for new lines have been added. Central has no time to look up numbers.

To permit an equitable use of the service on party lines, conversations should be limited to five minutes.

Do not listen on the line while other people are talking; this spoils the service for the parties talking cannot hear well if your receiver is off the hook.

The use of profane or obscene language over our wires is strictly forbidden.

Your phone is for your own use!

DO NOT HOLD YOUR RECEIVER OFF THE HOOK WHILE THE OPERATOR IS TRYING TO RING A PARTY — FOR THEN THE PHONE ON THE LINE WILL NOT RING CLEARLY AND DISTINCTLY AND THE PARTIES ON THE LINE CANNOT RECOGNIZE THE RINGS.

PLEASE DO ALL NECESSARY CALLING ON PARTY LINES BEFORE 10-00 P. M. MUCH LATE RINGING DISTURBS OTHER SUBSCRIBERS ON THE LINE.

Do not use phone in severe lightning storms.

Do not visit over the line with the operator. This impedes the service. Central is busy.

Talk directly into and not less than one inch from the transmitter. If you have a desk phone—hold the instrument straight up and down or your voice will not transmit clearly.

When your telephone is out of order, call up the manager or central from the telephone nearest you; the trouble will then be intelligently inquired into and removed.

If your telephone does not ring clearly and you cannot distinguish your ring—answer all rings until the line has been repaired. Central will ask for the party she wants.

As the company is responsible for the quality of the service, it is necessary to prohibit the use of any equipment not furnished by it.

This Company does not undertake to receive, transmit or deliver any message, written or verbal, and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for such message if received or transmitted by its employees.

While it is the aim of this Company to redress any grievances it is suggested that courtesy is equally commendable, whether practiced by telephone employee or subscriber.

Long distance rates and other long distance information will be gladly furnished upon application to the operator.

Tolls are charged to phone used and bills will be collected monthly.

Service charges are due and payable at the Company's office within the discount period shown on each bill. Accounts unpaid after the expiration of the discount period are over due and service is subject to suspension.

One copy of this Directory for each telephone is furnished each year without charge to every subscriber for use until replacement by another issue.

THE TIME LIMIT

The rules established by this company limiting single conversations on party lines to five minutes is designed for the benefit of all subscribers on party lines. Experience has shown that five minutes is sufficient time to complete the ordinary business or social transaction by telephone.

The company has therefore placed a limit of five minutes on single conversations on party lines but the enforcement of this rule, like many other regulations designed to give good service to all persons, requires the cooperation of subscribers for best results. It is not fair to your neighbor on the line for you to occupy it for long periods when he desires to use it.

It is a simple matter and a polite and neighborly act to relinquish the line after using it a reasonable period, allow your neighbor to have his talk, and then call your party again if you desire to add something to what you have already said.

If someone on a party line does unthinkingly hold the line over the time limit, and you want to use it, ask them to let you use it for your call. You will find that they will gladly cooperate.
